# MYLOL

WHAT ARE THE RISKS? MyLOs is a free social networking and dating site aimed at teens. Profiles can publicly display users' images and information, including sexual orientation and personal interests. The service bills itself as "the number one teen dating website in the world", claiming to have more than a million users globally. Despite its popularity, the MyLOs app is no longer evaluable from Google Play or the App Store, although the site is still active. In some countries, police forces and schools have previously warned parents about "sinister pregators" and "napprepriate activities" on the site.

#### FLIMSY AGE GATES

Although MyLOL states it is exclusively aimed at users aged between 13 and 13, there is no credible age verification system to prevent a younger child—or an older adult—from signing up to the platform. Coupled with the fact that it's impossible to establish a user's true identity on MyLOL, this raises a serious concern that the site could be used for arouning.

## AGE-INAPPROPRIATE CONTENT

MyLOL mointains that it monitors all uploaded images for nudity or sexual content. It also clotins to be able to detect suspicious keywords. However, there have been numerous reports of explicit content being found on the platform, with users often posting provocative, serni-nucle pictures of themselves and engaging in firty or sexually.

#### POTENTIAL CYBER-BULLYING

MyLOS, lets users "vote" on other people based solely on their appearance, much in the same voin as the now-defianct site Hot or Not. This feature could easily load to distress and bullying, especially if a young person's profile pics receive an unforcurable response. Various reviews of MyLO, have noted that bullying frequently becomes an issue in the platform's chart groups

#### IN-APP SPENDING

MyCOL is free to join and use, but it also afters paid-for memberships. Users who have paid money get their profile promoted at the top of the site and in search results. They can also earn additional credits for increased engagement with the statform — such as sharing, replying to messages and voting. At the time of writing, the monthly membership for was \$4.95 (just parted #84).

#### DATA COLLECTION

According to its privacy policy, (Illing MyLO), collects user data including email addresses, contact details and interests. While the company says it is committed to protecting users privacy, the small print states that information may be shared esternedly. MyCO, claims to follow procedures to keep data secure, but does not specify what these procedures are, or whether such information is energysted.

which, makes it easy to connect, with strangers, in fact, the site's ewards feature encourages users to send private messages to people buy don't know. There have been everal media stories of adults losing as beens on Myllot, to connect with minors, which could lead to stremely dengerous situations, such as a young person meeting up with someone who has been posting under a false identity.

## Advice for Parents & Carers

#### DISCUSS ONLINE DATING

It's vital to talk to your child about the possible dangers of platforms like MyLOL — particularly the threat of online predators. Remind them at the risks of shoring intimate images and intermation with strangers and emphasise that most people don't realise they're being 'catlished' until it's too late — it really lan't wise for a young person to meet up with someone they're and y spoken to online.

#### RESTRICT IN-APP SPENDING

If your child has access to a bank card or other payment method, they may be entitled into signing up for MyLOL's premium features. Having their profile beasted and receiving more attention could be especially tempting if their friends also use the site. You could consider altering their device's settings to disable internet purchases, or at the very least keeping an eye on their online spending.

#### EXPLAIN PRIVACY RISKS

Before your child begins using a service such as MyLOL, it's important that they understand the potential pittals of giving out their personal data on this type of platform. Explain to them, for example, that they shouldn't disulge any personally identifying information to people who they don't know, as scammers can be quite convincing when attempting to steal someone's identity.

#### SET UP LOCATION ALERTS

If you're worried that your child may be planning to meet up with someone they've met on MyLOL, you could consider utilising GPS or WIF! location tracking technology to follow their whereabouts in real time. You can even set up a virtual boundary or "fence" and opt to receive on alert to your phone if your child enters or exits a specified area.
